- Registration & briefing times for the afternoon elements will be provided after the trial closes, but are anticipated to be around noon or 1 pm.
- Trial will take place indoors and outdoors, rain or shine

SCENT INDICATION TEST: Birch, Anise & Clove (Saturday morning only)

ELEMENTS & LEVELS OFFERED:

SATURDAY:

Novice/Excellent (Morning): Containers, Exteriors, FastFinds, Interiors, Solo

Advanced (Afternoon): Containers, Exteriors, FastFinds, Interiors, Solo

SUNDAY:

Novice/Excellent (Morning): Containers, FastFinds, Interiors, Solo, Interiors 2. An Exteriors search is being offered for a sixth search for the Excellent level only on Sunday.

Advanced (Afternoon): Containers, FastFinds, Interiors, Solo, Interiors 2

Premier will be offered both Saturday and Sunday afternoon. There will be a separate premium that will be available on the K9 Scent Games and K-9 Scent Crew websites.

DIVISIONS OFFERED: FEO, Standard and Pro

ENTRY FEES: SITs: \$20 · Elements: \$25

Day of Trial if not filled: SITs: \$25 · Elements: \$30

Trial Judges: Cindy Martin (Lead Judge), Kathy Pierce and Diane Goff. It is possible that a provisional judge could be used, if necessary, to finish all searches in a timely manner.

Entry open date: Sunday, August 2, 2026. Entries are awarded via a random draw. A waitlist will be maintained if limits are exceeded.

Closing date for random draw: August 8, 2026

Cutoff Date/Trial close date: Monday, September 28, 2026

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Dogs must pass or have passed the Birch SIT (offered at this trial) in order for their Novice entries to qualify for Qs, titles, placements and awards.
- Dogs must have successfully passed both the Anise and Clove SITs in order to enter any elements at the Advanced or Excellent levels, even as FEO.
- Dogs who have passed an ORT from NACSW may waive the SIT for that odor.
- Dogs who have earned an NACSW NW3 title or an Excellent Overall title from AKC or a Superior Nosework title from UKC may skip the Novice level and begin at the Advanced level. Retired professional detection dogs may also skip Novice and enter in Advanced provided they pass the SITs for all three odors or show proof of earning an ORT title with NACSW. Proof must be emailed to the Trial Administrator prior to the event at k9scentcrew@yahoo.com . Please see rulebook for more details.
- **FEO- Novice Level:** Any dog can enter a Novice search at the Novice level with no previous requirements.
- **FEO- Advanced, Excellent and Premier Levels:** To enter a search in the Advanced or higher levels as FEO, dogs must have passed all three SITs or have earned an ORT title with NACSW or earned one qualifying score at the Excellent level in AKC or at the Superior level in UKC.
- All participants in this trial (competitors, staff, volunteers and spectators) will be required to sign a liability waiver. A link to the waiver will be emailed to you as we get closer to the trial.
- All dogs must be registered with an “Active” status to be entered. You can register your dog at www.K9ScentGames.fun

TRIAL ENTRY METHOD:

- **All entries for random draw must be made online at www.k9scentgames.fun** once the trial opens for entries (after the draw period, they will be made through a different process described below).
- Once the trial closes for random draw
 - The host will hold a random draw from all the online entries
 - Everyone entered in the trial will be notified via email as to whether their entry was drawn or placed on a waitlist. Please make sure to add k9scentcrew@yahoo.com and hello@k9scentgames.fun to your safe sender list.
 - The entry confirmation email will also include instructions for payment for the trial entries. Payments will be accepted via Venmo or with a check mailed to the Trial Administrator.
 - If you have Crew Cash from volunteering in the past, it can be redeemed if you choose.
- Entries submitted after the random draw:
 - If you did not enter before the random draw closing, you can still enter the trial by submitting an entry form available at <https://forms.gle/DjNAr9M5Ja7gQaZ48>. Once your entry is received and processed, you will be notified via email as to whether you are in the trial or on a waitlist.

CANCELLATIONS / MOVE UPS / CHANGES:

- Cancellations received on or before Monday, September 28, full refund less a \$20 processing fee.
- Cancellations received on or after Tuesday, September 29, there is **NO** refund
- Requests for changes or move-ups must be made via email to the Trial Administrator no later than September 28. After that date, no changes or refunds will be made.
- Changes and cancellations of your drawn entries can be made via your dashboard up until the **cutoff date of September 28**. After this date, any cancellations or entries must be sent to the Trial Administrator via email.
- If you earn a title in an entered element before this trial, please contact the Trial Administrator no later than Monday, September 28.
- **Move-ups:** During this trial weekend, move-ups will be allowed from Saturday to Sunday.

- Please remember that **you cannot enter an element for which the dog is not yet qualified in anticipation of earning a title.** However, you may enter that element as FEO and if you title, the entry can then be changed to Standard*. (**-Exceptions apply. Please see more details in the Rulebook*)
- **FEO:** FEO entries are allowed at this trial regardless of what level the dog qualifies for providing the SIT requirements, if any, are met.

INFO SPECIFIC TO THIS TRIAL:

Facility and Bathrooms: The school is climate controlled with possible variable floor surfaces throughout- hardwood, concrete, carpet, linoleum, etc. Some searches may be held in a gym with gym flooring. Outdoor searches in the school grounds may be paved, gravel or grassy. Parking is in a large paved lot. Please wear appropriate footwear.

There is no smoking / vaping allowed at this site outside of your vehicle. No alcohol allowed on premises.

Trial Site: Please do not visit or contact the trial site prior to the trial date. Also, no training should take place at the trial location. Please be respectful of this wonderful site and pick up after your dog.

Accessibility: There will be no steps into or out of the building. There could be moderately long walks from Exterior searches to the parking lot. There are sidewalks, mowed areas, gravel and paved roads to walk on.

Parking: There is a large, paved parking lot along the front of the school. There is NO SHADE, so please bring shade cloths if you wish. Please watch for cones or signs indicating an area is off limits for parking. Pop-up tents will not be allowed in the parking area.

RVs: There is space for daytime RV parking at this site. No overnight parking will be allowed. We have access to limited overnight off-site RV parking for a small fee. Please contact Theresa at k9scentcrew@yahoo.com.

Crating: There is NO indoor crating at this site. Be prepared to crate your dog(s) in your vehicles. Bring shade cloths, fans, water and anything else you need to keep your dog(s) comfortable.

Food: There will be no food available at the trial site. There are no restaurants close by so you will need to bring your own lunch/snacks/drinks.

GENERAL KSG TRIAL INFO:

Facebook Group: A Facebook group will be created specifically for this trial to post important information. The judge's video debriefings will also be posted in the group. You will receive more details via email closer to the trial.

General/Judge's Briefing: The briefing will be sent via email and will also be posted in the Facebook group on Friday evening after the final walkthrough with the judges. There will be a short in-person briefing and introductions to kick off the trial before the first dog runs. We will post the judges' video debriefings after the trial in the Facebook group.

Ribbons: Rosette placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 3rd place in the Standard division as well as new titles. Double-layer placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 3rd place in the Pro division. Ribbons will be awarded for qualifying searches in all elements in the Standard and Pro divisions as well as for SITs.

Golden Nose Award: We are excited to offer special recognition for those dogs who had an exceptional trialing day! To qualify for this coveted award at this trial, a dog must qualify in all 5 searches offered (regardless of the level) in Novice, Advanced or Excellent on Saturday and Sunday. **The Excellent Exteriors search on Sunday will not count towards the Golden Nose.**

For example: Spot is entered in Advanced Interiors, Advanced Solo and Advanced Containers as well as Novice FastFinds, Novice FastFinds 2 and Novice Exteriors. Since Spot is entered in one of each of the 6 elements offered, regardless of level, he is a contender for the Golden Nose award.

Moo Tips Award: One dog will be chosen from all the dogs that earn a Golden Nose Award during one trial day to receive this fun award- a personalized jar filled with all the swabs used at the trial that day signed by the Host and the Judge! The winner of this award will be chosen at the end of the trial day. There will be one Moo Tips Award given for the Novice/Advanced/Excellent levels (combined) and one given for the Premier level.

Awards: Ribbons and score sheets will be handed out after all placements are tallied after each level has completed their searches. Please allow time for the Score Room to tally the scores and get the awards ready.

Spectators will generally be welcomed at KSG trials. However, whether spectators are allowed in a particular search or not will be determined by the Judge as well as by the Handler. A Handler has the right to choose to not have spectators during their search.

Volunteers will help our trial run smoothly. We need Timers, Gate Stewards, Score Runners, and others. No Experience Required! No need to give up a day-volunteers get to run first in their element if needed. Thanks in advance for your help. You can sign up to volunteer at <https://forms.gle/LWX6iTtMZ8GQSNCG8>.

Collars: Any collar is allowed on the grounds except scent spraying collars. During a search, leashes must be attached to either a flat collar, a martingale collar or to the back d-ring on a harness. No hanging tags while searching. No retractable leashes are allowed except in the search areas. All dogs must be leashed at all times, except during an off-leash search.

Dogs In Need of Space: The parking area is large and there is plenty of room to spread out. Although it is encouraged for a reactive dog to wear a red bandana, it is not required, so **please give all dogs space.**

Dogs in Season: Females in season may participate wearing appropriate britches at all times except in the toileting areas. Females in season will run after the last dog in each search. Handlers must notify the Trial Administrator as soon as possible so accommodations may be made for toileting areas and run order adjustments.

Handler running multiple dogs: A handler may only run one dog in each element or SIT test for a qualifying score, placements or awards. A second or third dog can run FEO in the same element or in a different element or SIT test.

Titles from other Organizations: Dogs who have passed an ORT from NACSW may waive the SITs for those odors. Dogs who have earned an NW3 title from NACSW, an Excellent Overall title from AKC or a Superior Nosework title from UKC may skip Novice level and begin at Advanced. Retired professional detection dogs may also skip Novice and enter in Advanced provided they pass the SITs for all three odors or show proof of passing an ORT for all three odors. Proof for any of the requirements above must be emailed to the Trial Administrator prior to the event at k9scentcrew@yahoo.com . Please see rulebook for more details.

COVID Guidelines: Specific COVID precautions will be announced, if needed, closer to the trial date via email. There may or may not be a COVID waiver that everyone attending the trial will need to sign. CDC guidelines regarding masks will be used to form our decision about any masking requirements for those searches that are conducted in an interior setting.

Permission has been granted by K9 Scent Games to host a scent work competition following KSG Rules and Regulations.
